## Terms of Use

Last Updated: March 25, 2026 · Version 1.0

Thank you for using Socrian. These Terms of Use (“Terms”) govern your access to and use of the Socrian Chrome extension (the “Extension”). Please read them carefully. They are written in plain language because we want you to understand what you are agreeing to, not just accept a wall of legal text.

By installing or using Socrian, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, please uninstall the Extension and do not use it.

## 1. Who We Are

Socrian is a Chrome browser extension built to help students study more effectively. It connects to your Google Classroom account and uses AI to generate flashcards, study notes, and practice questions from your course materials. We are an independent software developer. If you have questions about these Terms, please contact us through our Chrome Web Store listing page.

## 2. Eligibility

To use Socrian, you must:

- Be at least 13 years of age. Socrian is not intended for children under 13, and by using the Extension you represent that you meet this minimum age requirement.
- Have a valid Google account with access to Google Classroom.
- Agree to these Terms on your own behalf, or, if you are between 13 and 17 years old, with the knowledge and consent of a parent or guardian.

If you are using Socrian as part of an educational institution, you represent that you have the authority to accept these Terms and that your use complies with your institution’s policies.

## 3. The Extension and What It Does

Socran provides the following core functionality:

- Connecting to your Google Classroom account to retrieve a list of your enrolled courses, assignments, and attached materials.
- Accessing Google Drive files attached to Classroom materials that you explicitly select.
- Sending the text content of selected materials to Google's Gemini API to generate AI-powered flashcards, study notes, and practice questions.
- Displaying the AI-generated study content within the Extension interface.

The Extension is a tool to assist your studying. It is not a substitute for your own engagement with course material, and AI-generated content may contain inaccuracies. You are responsible for verifying the accuracy of any content Socran generates before relying on it.

## 4. Your Account and Responsibilities

### 4.1 Your Google Account

Socran accesses Google services through your Google account via OAuth 2.0. You are responsible for maintaining the security of your Google account, including your password and any two-factor authentication settings. Socran does not have access to your Google account password and cannot be held responsible for unauthorized access to your Google account.

### 4.2 Acceptable Use

You agree to use Socran only for lawful purposes and in accordance with these Terms. You agree not to:

- Use the Extension to access, retrieve, or process materials that you do not have the right to access under your Google account permissions.
- Attempt to reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, or otherwise derive the source code of the Extension beyond what is permitted by applicable law.
- Use the Extension in any way that could damage, disable, overburden, or impair our services or the third-party services Socran depends on.
- Circumvent, disable, or otherwise interfere with any usage limits or security features of the Extension.

- Use the Extension to generate content for purposes other than your own personal study and academic use.
- Represent AI-generated content produced by Socrian as your own original work in academic submissions in a manner that violates your institution's academic integrity policies.

## 4.3 Academic Integrity

Socrian is designed to help you study — not to do your work for you. Using AI-generated flashcards and study notes to learn is legitimate; submitting AI-generated content as your own original work may not be, depending on your institution's policies. You are solely responsible for understanding and complying with your school's academic integrity guidelines. We do not monitor or control how you use content generated by the Extension.

# 5. Subscriptions and Payments

## 5.1 Free and Paid Tiers

Socrian offers both a free tier and a paid subscription tier. The features available on each tier are described within the Extension and on our Chrome Web Store listing. We reserve the right to change the features available on each tier with reasonable notice.

## 5.2 Payment Processing

All subscription payments are processed by ExtensionPay ([extensionpay.com](https://extensionpay.com)). We do not collect, receive, or store your payment card information. By subscribing, you also agree to ExtensionPay's terms of service and privacy policy. Any billing disputes should be directed to ExtensionPay.

## 5.3 Billing and Cancellation

Subscriptions renew automatically on a recurring basis unless you cancel before the renewal date. You can cancel your subscription at any time through ExtensionPay. Cancellation takes effect at the end of your current billing period. We do not offer prorated refunds for partial billing periods, except where required by applicable law.

## 5.4 Usage Limits

Socran enforces daily AI usage limits, which vary by subscription tier. These limits are tracked locally on your device using a simple token counter. If you reach your daily limit, the Extension will restrict AI generation features until the following day. We reserve the right to adjust usage limits with reasonable notice.

## **6. Intellectual Property**

### **6.1 The Extension**

Socran and all content, features, and functionality within it — including but not limited to the software, design, and structure of the Extension — are owned by us and protected by applicable intellectual property laws. These Terms do not transfer any intellectual property rights to you. You are granted a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to install and use the Extension solely for your personal, non-commercial study purposes in accordance with these Terms.

### **6.2 Your Content**

We do not claim ownership of any materials you access through Google Classroom or Google Drive using the Extension. Those materials belong to you, your instructors, or your educational institution, as applicable. You represent that your access to and use of those materials through Socran complies with any applicable terms of service, license, or permission governing those materials.

### **6.3 AI-Generated Content**

The flashcards, notes, and practice questions generated by Socran are produced by Google's Gemini API based on content you supply. We do not claim ownership of AI-generated output. You are free to use it for your personal study purposes. We make no representations about the intellectual property status of AI-generated content under applicable law, and you use it at your own risk.

## **7. Third-Party Services**

Socran depends on third-party services to function. Your use of those services through Socran is also subject to their own terms and policies:

- Google APIs (Classroom, Drive, Gemini): Subject to Google’s Terms of Service ([policies.google.com/terms](https://policies.google.com/terms)) and, for AI features, Google’s Generative AI Additional Terms of Service.
- ExtensionPay: Subscription and payment management is governed by ExtensionPay’s terms, available at [extensionpay.com](https://extensionpay.com).

We are not responsible for the actions, content, or policies of these third-party services. If a third-party service changes its API, terms, or availability in a way that affects Socrian’s functionality, we will try to adapt promptly but cannot guarantee uninterrupted service.

## 8. Disclaimers

We are not responsible for any academic consequences arising from reliance on inaccurate AI-generated content.

## 9. Limitation of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, we will not be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or punitive damages arising out of or related to your use of Socrian, including but not limited to:

- Loss of data or unauthorized access to your Google account.
- Academic penalties arising from your use of AI-generated content.
- Interruptions to service caused by changes to third-party APIs or Chrome platform updates.
- Any other loss or damage arising from your use of or inability to use the Extension.

Our total liability to you for any claims arising from these Terms or your use of Socrian will not exceed the amount you paid us for your current subscription period, or ten U.S. dollars (\$10.00), whichever is greater. Some jurisdictions do not allow limitations on liability for certain types of damages, so some of these limitations may not apply to you.

## 10. Indemnification

### 11.1 By You

You may stop using Socrian at any time by uninstalling the Extension. If you have a paid subscription, uninstalling the Extension does not automatically cancel your subscription — you must cancel through ExtensionPay separately. See Section 5.3.

### 11.2 By Us

We reserve the right to suspend or discontinue the Extension, or to terminate your access to it, at any time and for any reason, including if we believe you have violated these Terms. We will

try to provide reasonable notice before discontinuing the Extension entirely, but we cannot guarantee advance notice in all circumstances.

### **11.3 Effect of Termination**

Upon termination of your use of the Extension, all licenses granted to you under these Terms will immediately terminate. Sections of these Terms that by their nature should survive termination — including disclaimers, limitation of liability, indemnification, and governing law — will survive.

## **12. Changes to These Terms**

We may update these Terms from time to time as Socrian evolves or as legal requirements change. When we make material changes, we will update the “Last Updated” date at the top of these Terms and, where feasible, provide notice through the Chrome Web Store listing or within the Extension itself.

Your continued use of the Extension after updated Terms are posted constitutes your acceptance of the revised Terms. If you do not agree to the changes, you should uninstall the Extension.

## **13. Governing Law and Disputes**

These Terms are governed by the laws of the jurisdiction in which we are based, without regard to conflict of law principles. If you have a dispute with us arising from these Terms or your use of Socrian, we encourage you to contact us first so we can try to resolve it informally.

To the extent permitted by applicable law, any disputes that cannot be resolved informally will be subject to binding arbitration or the jurisdiction of the courts in our home jurisdiction. Nothing in this section prevents you from asserting consumer rights to which you may be entitled under applicable local law.

## 14.1 Entire Agreement

These Terms, together with our Privacy Policy, constitute the entire agreement between you and us regarding Socrian and supersede any prior agreements or understandings.

## 14.2 Severability

If any provision of these Terms is found to be invalid or unenforceable, that provision will be modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it enforceable, and the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.

## 14.3 No Waive

Our failure to enforce any provision of these Terms will not constitute a waiver of our right to enforce that provision in the future.

You may not assign or transfer your rights under these Terms without our prior written consent. We may assign our rights under these Terms, including in connection with a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, without restriction.
